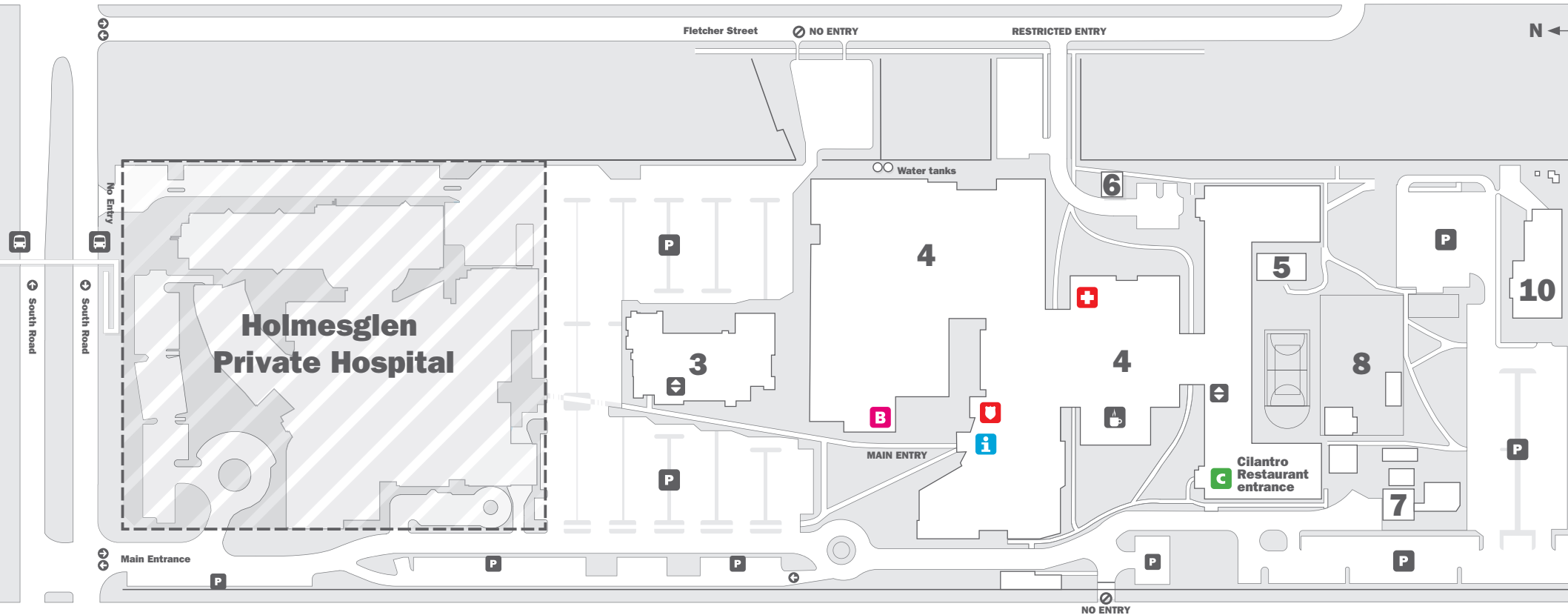

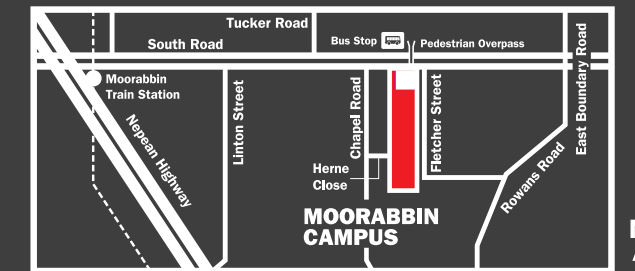
GETTING HERE

Train
